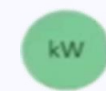

Emphasize influence, communication, and engagement in your approach

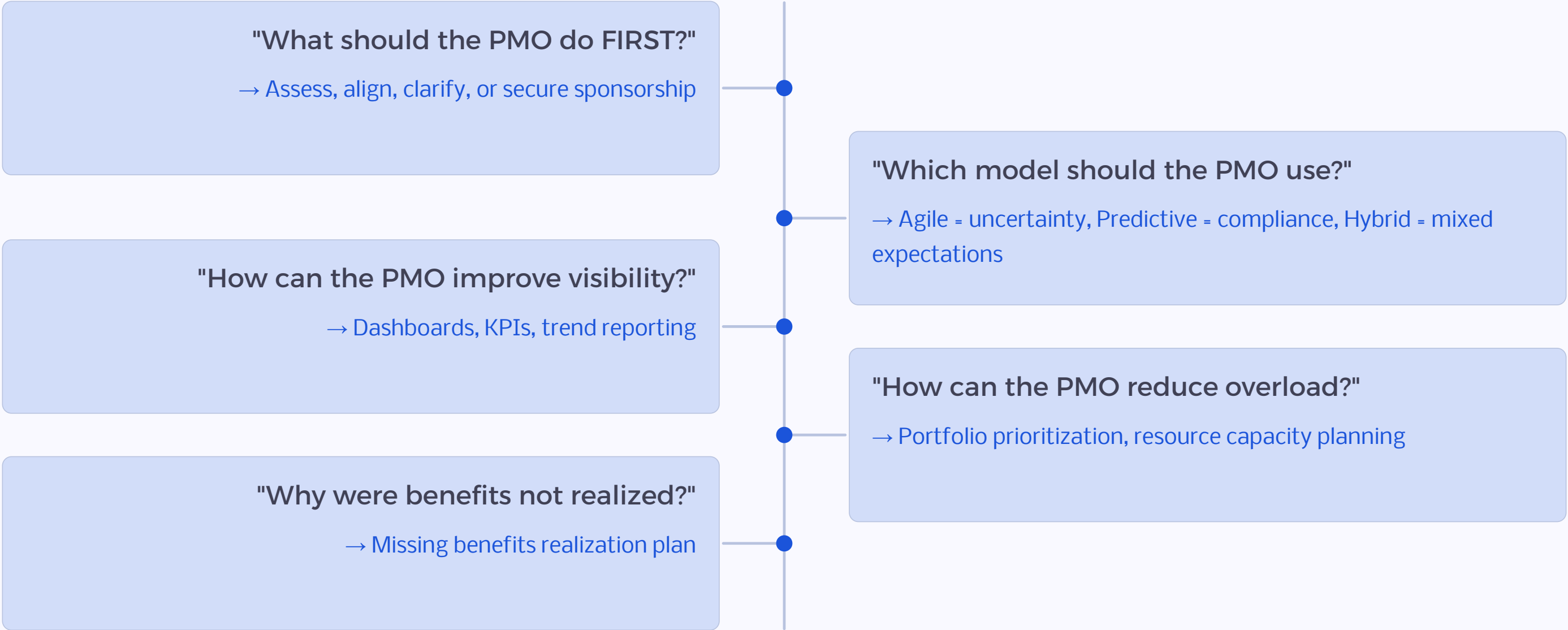
